It will also explain why providing amplification with a BAHS device can be so beneficial for those patients that fulfill the indication criteria. Lastly, the course will explain why increasing the MFO of a BAHS device benefits all BAHS candidates, and take a brief look at the effect different methods of sound transmission (available with a BAHS device) can have.
