### WAC 246-828-075 Supervisors of students

Supervised practicum: Including hands-on experience with patients.

- (i) The supervised practicum must consist of a minimum of five hundred twenty hours.
- (ii) Two hundred sixty of the five hundred twenty hours must be directly supervised. The remaining hours may be directly or indirectly supervised.
- (iii) Methods of instruction on effective communication strategies for individuals with hearing impairments.

"Direct supervision" means the supervisor is on-site and in view during the procedures or tasks.

"Indirect supervision" means the procedures or tasks are performed under the supervising speech-language pathologist's, audiologist's, or hearing aid specialist's overall direction and control and the supervisor is accessible, but the supervisor's presence is not required during the performance of procedures or tasks.
